

## **Harmony Fire District Update**

It has now been over a year since we finished our new building. We have enjoyed our time at the new location, which is finally feeling like home. We have responded to over 700 calls for help in the last year which marks our busiest year in our history.



This is no small task for our volunteers, and we continue to need your help. We are often asked what we need most for our operation and the answer remains the same. We need people. We are always looking for quality volunteers with a heart to serve. Our Junior Firefighter program, which accepts high school students aged 14-17 years old, is bursting at the seams. These Junior Firefighters can participate in drills, training, and respond to calls in accordance with child labor laws. These members are frequently children of senior members, or friends of other Juniors. While this area of our membership is growing fast, our Brigade Members, the interior qualified firefighters and rescue technicians, are still in need of help. Our recent SAFER grant award has allowed us to provide increased training opportunities for these members, NFPA compliant physicals for new members, and offset the costs of new turn out gear for those who are trained to a minimum of Firefighter 1, a national standard for basic training of firefighters. This award has also allowed us to implement a Stipend Program, which reimburses members a small stipend for staffing the Zelienople station during predetermined shift periods. We are working tirelessly to improve how we serve our communities.

While all these activities are going on, you may have also noticed a change in some of our apparatus. We were able to sell our tanker, which was no longer deemed necessary for our area, for the original purchase price. That sale allowed us to purchase a reserve engine and make a significant deposit into our savings account to move us into a much stronger financial position for long term capital planning. We also added a UTV to our fleet in the last year. This purchase was made possible by our Auxiliary Committee working hard to raise funds through various fundraisers to fill a void in our operation. This UTV is a Can-Am Defender and will allow us to respond further from the roadway for both brush fires and patient retrieval when needed. Finally, planning for the future, the District continues to work with local, state, and federal representatives to secure funding for our fleet replacement needs, which will include delivery of a new engine in 2026.

We would like to take a moment and thank all of you for your continued support. The District has grown as fast as our community has over the last several years. The financial support we receive from our fundraisers and our fund drive mailers continue to be vital to our operation. Our members look forward to continuing to serve our great communities.

## **4 Corners Park** Redesign





The Borough, in partnership with private donors, the American Legion, and Explore Zelie, will be redesigning and rededicating the Veterans Memorial Park along Main Street. This meaningful project is dedicated to honoring the memory and service of all our local veterans who have served in the United States Armed Forces.

The project includes a redesign of the memorial layout, including removing and replacing trees, cleaning and refinishing of the existing monuments, and the installation of additional monuments. Please note that residents and visitors can expect construction activity in the area of the Four Corner Park during this time, including the removal of some trees as part of the redesign.

This community effort is made possible through the collaboration and support of Explore Zelie, the American Legion, and private donors.
