## BOROUGH OF ZELIENOPLE BUTLER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ORDINANCE NO. #894-25

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF ZELIENOPLE, BUTLER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2026

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Zelienople, Butler County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

That the taxes be and are hereby levied on all property within the said Borough, subject to taxation for Borough purposes, for the fiscal year 2026, as follows:

**SECTION 1**. Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 1.81 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 2**. Tax rate for recreation purposes, the sum of 2.00 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 3.** Tax rate for fire purposes, the sum of 3.00 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 4**. Tax rate for library purposes, the sum of 1.57 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

**SECTION 5.** Tax rate for ambulance and rescue (EMS) purposes, the sum of 0.50 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

## **SECTION 5.**

The same being summarized in tabular form as follows:

**SECTION 6**. All other municipal tax rates are to remain unchanged.
