CONSIDER FINAL APPROVAL OF A MINOR SUBDIVISION TO INCLUDE A REVERSE SUBDIVISION AT 122 SOUTH JEFFERSON AND 124 SOUTH JEFFERSON STREET

A motion was made by Mr. Geis, seconded by Mr. Mrs. Hess to give final approval for a minor subdivision to include a reverse subdivision which combines two lots to create one lot at 122 South Jefferson and 124 South Jefferson Street. As part of the Zoning Hearing Board granting approval for a Use Variance, a condition on the Applicant, Thomas G. Myers and Miranda Berner, that the two lots of record be combined into one lot of .29 acres, or 12,632 square feet.
