A motion was made by Mr. Spencer Mathew, seconded by Mr. Foyle, to approve Zelienople Area Business Association's Special Event Permit Application for Small Business Saturday to be held on November 25, 2023 from 10:00 AM to 7:00 PM in the Main Street business district provided that the responsible party noted in the application coordinate communications with and be responsive to the Chief of Police and Public Works Director as needed and comply with the Borough of Zelienople's Special Event Rules, Code of Ordinances Chapter 174, Special Events and Alcoholic Beverages, Parades & Public Gatherings & all applicable Federal, State, and Local laws.

CONSIDER AUTHORIZATION TO REPLACE ADA RAMP AND SIDEWALK REPAIR AT HIGH STREET AND NEW CASTLE STREET

A motion was made by Mrs. Reeb, seconded by Mr. Spencer Mathew, to authorize the replacement of the ADA ramp and sidewalk repair at High Street and New Castle Street in the amount of \$6,200.00. The ADA ramp at High Street and New Castle Street has deteriorated and needs to be replaced. In order to meet new ADA requirements, additional sidewalks will also need to be replaced. Franzcrete LLC provided a quote of \$6,200.00 to make the necessary repairs to the ADA ramp and sidewalk.

CONSIDER AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE TRANSFORMERS

A motion was made by Mr. Foyle, seconded by Mr. Mathew, to authorize the purchase of transformers from T&R Electric in the amount of \$64,411.00 for electric service upgrades at four properties in the Borough and will require upgrades to the transformer equipment.

CONSIDER AUTHORIZATION TO ADVERTISE THE PROPOSED 2024 OPERATING BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN

A motion was made by Mr. Geis, seconded by Mrs. Reeb, to authorize the advertisement of the proposed 2024 operating budget and corresponding Capital Improvements Plan for public inspection.

The proposed 2024 Operating Budget and proposed Capital Improvements Plan has been prepared by staff and reviewed with the Finance Committee. An advertisement of the proposed budget must be made noting its availability for public inspection for a ten-day period before Council can formally adopt the budget. The adoption must take place prior to December 31, 2023. We will plan on the final adoption of the proposed budget at the December 11, 2023 meeting, unless another special meeting is proposed.
