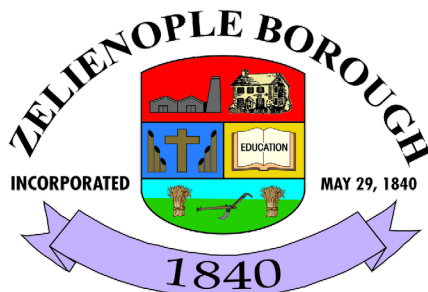

Zelienople Borough Presents 2022 Volunteer of the Year Award to Neal Jackson

Zelienople Borough will present the 2022 Volunteer of the Year Award to Neal Jackson at the Borough Council Meeting on August 28, 2023 at 7:30 p.m.

Jackson, a lifelong Zelienople resident, has been involved with the Rotary Club of Zelienople and Zelienople Area Business Association (ZABA) since 1994. He is the secretary of the Rotary Club and has served as one of the chief coordinators of the Fourth of July Parade, a Zelienople staple, for more than 15 years.
